## **ASPHALT PAVING 13 AVENUE BETWEEN TRANS CANADA WAY, 28 STREET**

**Medicine Hat** – The City of Medicine is asphalt paving portions of 13 Avenue between Trans-Canada Way and 28 Street starting Saturday, Sept. 24, 2005.

The work, which includes asphalt milling and paving, will be completed in two phases. The first phase involves work outside of the intersection of 13 Avenue and Southview Drive. Phase one work should be completed by Monday, Sept. 26.

The second phase, which will be completed in 2006, will involve work in the intersection of 13 Avenue and Southview Drive. The work will be completed in two phases for the safety of construction workers and to minimize disruptions to the motoring public.

Once the work is complete there will be new asphalt between 28 Street and Trans-Canada Way.

The City asks motorists to obey all traffic sign and signals, and to drive slowly in the construction zone.
