UTILITY CONSTRUCTION ALONG SOUTH BOUNDARY ROAD

Medicine Hat –Utility upgrades on the shoulder and in the ditch of South Boundary Road began this week.

The work, which includes placement of a waterline running along South Boundary Road from the intersection with Highway 3 (Gershaw Drive) to 13 Ave., is scheduled to be completed by Dec. 15, 2005.

This construction may limit travel to one lane and will include some road closures. Traffic delays are expected from the start of construction until completion. Closure of South Boundary Road from Ranger Road 61A to Highway 3 (Gershaw Drive) is expected from Nov. 1 to Nov. 28, 2005.

Motorists are asked to obey all traffic sign and signals, and drive slowly in the construction zone.
